Objet- Re – Betreff Decision taken by the group of experts concerning the arrangements for acquisition and the procedure for purchase of the technological tool with the characteristics required by the mathematics syllabuses, as approved by the Board of Governors at its meeting of 14-16 April 2010, by the parents and by the teachers

On behalf of the group of experts responsible for choosing the technological tool to be deployed in the context of the mathematics syllabuses, I am writing to inform you, by means of this memorandum, of the decision taken by the group, which convened at the Office of the Secretary-General on 4 May 2018. This decision was taken during the meeting, chaired by Mrs Laczynska, Nursery and Primary Inspector and the Inspector in charge of mathematics for the secondary cycle for the European Schools.

DECISION

In accordance with the arrangements for acquisition of the technological tool with the characteristics required by the mathematics syllabuses, as defined in document 2010-D-242-en-3 and the annexes thereto, approved by the Board of Governors, and following an analysis of developments in the hardware and software available, the group of experts in charge of choice of the technological tool, which convened at the Office of the Secretary-General of the European Schools on 4 May 2018, recommended to accompany the mathematics syllabuses for secondary years s4, s5, s6 and s7 of the European Schools as

*In accordance with the characteristics required by the mathematics syllabuses for years s4, s5, s6 and s7 and by decision of the group of experts, which convened on 4 May 2018, at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year in September 2018, each student must have the **TI-Nspire CX CAS calculator, equipped with version 4.5.X.X or higher of the software.***
