## **People In Focus: The Transport Team**

As of February 2023, we wish to focus on key people or teams and give them a deserved highlight in our newsletters. Today, we focus on the Transport Service, core activity of the APEEE, with **130 buses** and an average of 23 000 school bus journeys each school year, which is run by an administrative **team of 6 people**, including a manager, the famous Mr Nguyen, who has been with the APEEE for 15 years! The team is **on site as of 6h45** for the arrival operations, cancelled buses, unavailable supervisors, to answer calls, manage delays, plan bus supervision, hire new supervisors, etc. They also run the departures (two at 15h30 & one at 16h20) and the topics linked to them: creation/modification of routes and stops, wrong bus, accompany a friend, exceptional requests, lost or forgotten belongings and more.

The team is always available during opening hours and tries to



reply as quickly as possible to all the requests received by email or telephone.
