Dear parents,

This week I sent you a mail to ask your opinion on the proposals for the future linguistic structure of the European Schools in Brussels. These proposals concern us all and most prominently each and every one of you. It will be a basis for the decisions of the school system until 2028. Food and fuel prices will continue to affect the conditions to provide our children with food, transport and after school activities. The integration of Evere as a permanent site of our school will have to be further increased.

So there are a number of challenges ahead this year. I will keep you informed. However don't hesitate to contact your section representatives or the APEEE secretariat in case of questions, ideas or comments.
