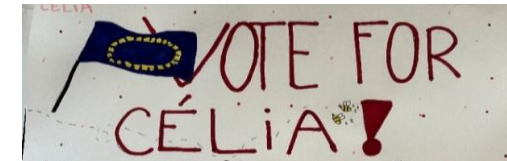
## Motivation:

## Achievements in 2024:

- **Coordinated the Wellbeing Working Group (WG)** and led the revision of the mobile device policy.
- **Coordinated the Education Council for Primary and Nursery (CEP&M) WG.**
- Organized a P5 to S1 parent transition meeting.
- Organized the "Navigating Technology and Internet Safety" workshop with Dr. Eva Wieler.
- **Advocated and achieved** the reinstatement P5 end-of-year and P1 start-of-year **ceremonies.**
- Advocated and enabled more access of parents to school e.g art show.
- Helped the school with the Footfest organization – bought the Tombola in May 2024 with Elita.
- Coordinated the second-hand ski sale at the Christmas Market.

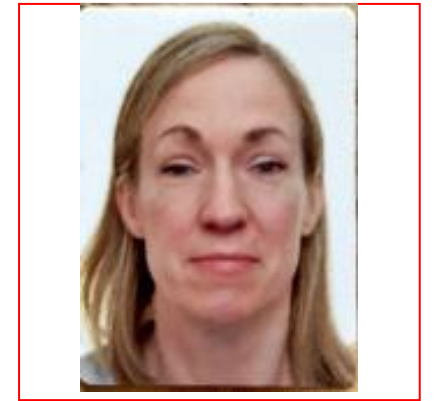
